

- 1) There are two sets of puzzle questions – “A” and “B”. The “A” question and the “B” question with the same number (such as “A1” and “B1”) are for the same type of object. The “B” questions are a little harder.
- 2) If you know the answer to any of the “A” questions, write the answer on the dotted line, using one space (one little line) for each letter. The “B” questions have both dotted lines to fill in the same way, and additional long spaces that you can answer with whole words.
- 3) Below some of the spaces is a number. Find the space with the same number in the secret message at the bottom of the page, and write the same letter in that space.
- 4) If you fill in all the dotted lines, you can solve the puzzle at the bottom of the page!
